ORDER

Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 5(e), Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure 5005(a) (2) and 9011 and Local Rule B-5005-4 authorize this Court to establish practices and procedures for the filing, signing and verification of pleadings and papers by electronic means. The Court has reviewed the proposed Administrative Procedures Concerning Electronic Case Files.

- (1) The Administrative Procedures Concerning Electronic Case Files in this Court, including the procedure for registration of attorneys and for distribution of passwords to permit electronic filing and notice of pleadings and other papers, are hereby **APPROVED**.
- (2) The provisions of this Order shall apply to all electronically filed cases and proceedings that are filed in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of Indiana.
- (3) Amendments to this Order may be entered from time to time in keeping with the needs of the Court.
