ORDER

In order to implement the requirements of S.D. Ind. L.R. 83.5(c), which apply to proceedings in this Bankruptcy Court, the following procedures shall apply to motions to appear *pro hac vice*:

1. The Court will not consider or act upon any motion to appear *pro hac vice* unless, in addition to complying with any other requirements that may govern admission *pro hac vice*, the motion is accompanied by:

- a. A check payable to the "Clerk, United States District Court" in the amount of \$30.00; and
- b. A proposed form of order granting the motion to appear.

2. If the motion to appear *pro hac vice* is granted, the Clerk of the Bankruptcy Court shall forward movant's check to the Clerk of the United States District Court for the Southern District of Indiana along with a copy of the order granting the motion. If the motion to appear *pro hac vice* is denied, the Clerk of the Bankruptcy Court shall return the fee to the movant along with a copy of the order denying the motion.

3. The Court may refuse to consider or act upon any request for relief (other than a motion to appear *pro hac vice*) filed by any attorney who, pursuant to S.D. Ind. L.R. 83.5(c), is required to obtain leave to appear and has failed to do so.
