AMENDED ORDER


The United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of Indiana hereby amends its General Order 03-0009 dated April 30, 2003, as follows:

The Motion will not be considered unless the deficiency is cured or a showing of good cause is made as to why additional time is needed.
