ORDER

By General Order 05-0001, dated May 2nd, 2005, this Court previously established the requirements for use of electronic filing. That order is now rescinded, and replaced with this order and the following requirements:

- 1. All attorneys shall file all cases and pleadings electronically, using the Court's CM/ECF system and in accordance with the Court's Electronic Case Filing Administrative Policies and Procedures Manual ("the Manual").
- 2. A non-attorney who has registered as a limited user shall file documents using the Court's CM/ECF system, in accordance with the Manual and such other guidance as has been posted by the Clerk concerning the rights of limited users.
- 3. All others shall file cases, pleadings and documents on paper, except that the creditor matrix for any case must be submitted on a diskette or other electronic media acceptable to the Clerk. Petitions and pleadings must contain the original signature of the party filing same.
