System Requirements:


- A current PACER registration
- Adobe Acrobat or Adobe Reader version 7 or greater
- Windows Media Player (for .mp3 file playback)

Accessing the Digital Audio File from the docket:

- 1. Login with your PACER account.
- 2. Select Reports from the blue menu bar.
- 3. Select the **Docket Report**.



- 4. Enter the desired case number
- 5. Click on Run Report.




6. The docket will display. Locate the hearing date and PDF with Audio File.

- 7. Click on the docket entry number to display the PDF. The Hearing information will come up.
- 8. Click on the Attachment or Paper Clip icon to display a link to the MP3 file. If you have difficulty locating the audio file, see section titled "Methods for Acessing Audio Files Attached to a PDF file"



**Note: The audio files are in MP3 format and embedded as an attachment to a PDF (Windows Media Play will play MP3 files by defaulut). **


9. The Attachment window will then be shown. **Double Click** on the embedded audio file to open it (you can also click on the embedded audio file and then click **open** or **save**).



10. **Click OK** to open. The file and your default audio player will pop-up and begin playing the audio file.

Methods for Accessing Audio Files Attached to a PDF File


To access an audio file, click on the attachments (paper clip) icon on the left side of the application. The panel will expand, double click the file to load it into a media player.

Click on View, Show/Hide, Navigation Panes, Attachments



Finding the Attachments icon in Adobe Reader

Click on the Adobe symbol in the floating menu at the bottom of the page
