**NOTICE OF INDIANAPOLIS CHAMBERS
AND COURTROOM RELOCATIONS IN EARLY 2015**

With Judge Otte's departure at the end of calendar 2014, the Indianapolis courthouse will once again be the assigned duty station for only three Bankruptcy Judges. After a series of small renovation projects, each of the three remaining Judges will be in new chambers and using a different courtroom.

The first transition will be by Chief Judge Robyn Moberly, who will move from her current location into the chambers and courtroom currently used by Judge Otte.

Thereafter, Judge Jeffrey Graham will move into the chambers and courtroom currently used by Judge Moberly. Judge James Carr will move into the space vacated by Judge Graham (the former Judge Coachys chambers and courtroom). Then Judge Basil Lorch III will return to the visiting Judge chambers and courtroom – where Judge Carr is currently located.

Because several of the relocations are dependent on the completion of renovation work, the exact dates are unknown. For the foreseeable future, hearing notices will use each Judge's current courtroom. Notices posted on the website – and signage in the hallway – will advise when a Judge's hearings have moved to a new courtroom.

The chart below shows each Judge's courtroom AFTER all moves have been completed:
