TRANSFER OF CASES TO JUDGE CARR**

The Court has begun the process of transferring cases to our newest Bankruptcy Judge, James M. Carr. Judge Carr began receiving new cases January 2, 2013, but since Judge Otte retained his existing caseload upon his recall to service, the Judges decided to transfer some pending cases to Judge Carr.

The process will take approximately one month, and may affect any Indianapolis Division case pending under any Chapter. (Adversary proceedings are also being transferred, but only in conjunction with the transfer of the main case.)

If you are involved in a case that is transferred, you will get notice through a docket entry sent electronically. Cases are being identified as candidates for transfer using several criteria, including the absence of a scheduled hearing (except for Chapter 11 cases, which have already been transferred). If you believe a case has been transferred erroneously, contact a Courtroom Deputy for the Judge originally assigned the matter.
