**ORDER**

The Court previously entered General Order 13-003, to clarify which general orders remain in effect and which have been superseded by local rules edits or otherwise rendered obsolete. Since 2013, several more general orders have been incorporated into the local rules or are no longer necessary because the problem addressed was temporary (i.e., an order extending filing deadlines because CM/ECF was unavailable). The Court now updates the status of its general orders as follows:

(1) The following general orders are still in effect as of this date:


- 09-0005: treatment of current mortgage payments in Ch.13 plans
- 10-0001: directing informal dispute resolution in New Albany Ch.13 cases
- 12-0006: adopting the latest version of interim rule 1007-I
- 14-0003: installment fees payment schedule
- 14-0005: setting maximum fee for Ch. 13 cases
- 14-0006: waiving fee for protective order motions under FRBP 9037
- 16-0002: establishing mortgage loss mitigation program for Ch.13 cases
- 16-0004: regarding deposit and investment of registry funds

(2) General orders adopting changes to the local rules remain effective, but shall be archived and removed from view to the public 30 days after the effective date of the rules changes in those orders. The current version of the local rules always supersedes any earlier general order.

(3) A general order rescinding another general order, and the order that was rescinded, shall be archived and removed from view to the public 30 days after the issuance of the order rescinding.

(4) Only the general orders listed in paragraph (1) and any future general order not subject to archiving pursuant to paragraphs (2) and (3) shall appear on the Court's website. All other general orders shall be archived and removed from view to the public. Any paper versions of these General Orders shall be retained by the Clerk after being marked "Rescinded."
