
ORDER

In accordance with the policies of the Judicial Conference, the Court now authorizes the Bankruptcy Clerk to refund fees without court order, if the Bankruptcy Clerk determines that no fee was owed or that a fee was paid more than once, and if the fee was paid using pay.gov, effective immediately.

In such circumstances, upon the filing of a Motion for Refund the Clerk may process the refund if it meets the set criteria. The Court will then enter an order that the motion has been rendered moot by the Clerk's actions.

This order in no way affects the Clerk's existing power to edit the Court's records and remove a fee that is not owed from an attorney's account before payment.
