ORDER

An entity (other than an attorney, a pro se debtor, or a petition preparer) filing more than ten (10) paper documents in bankruptcy cases or proceedings per calendar year shall be required to file electronically either by registering as a limited user pursuant to the Court's ECF Administrative Policies and Procedures Manual or by using the Court's Electronic Proof of Claim filing system. Thereafter, the entity shall file all documents electronically; failure to do so may result in an order to show cause and the rejection of paper filings.

The Clerk shall, on an annual basis and based upon filing information from the prior calendar year, give notice by mail of this general order to affected entities. This general order becomes effective as to an affected entity 30 days after notice is sent.

This order supersedes Amended General Order 09-0011 entered on June 14, 2013.
