Chief Judge Frank H. Easterbrook of the United States Court of Appeals for the Seventh Circuit is pleased to announce the appointment of James M. Carr to a 14-year term as United States Bankruptcy Judge for the United States District Court for the Southern District of Indiana. He will take office on January 1, 2013.

Mr. Carr earned his bachelors degree from Indiana University. He graduated magna cum laude from Indiana University Maurer School of Law and was Order of the Coif. He started working at Baker and Daniels after law school and was a partner there as well as at its successor, Faegre Baker Daniels. He specialized in bankruptcy, financial restructuring, and commercial litigation law.

He is a member of the American Bar Association, the Indianapolis Bar Association (where he has served as chair of the Commercial and Bankruptcy Law Section), the Indiana State Bar Association (where he has served as chair of the Bankruptcy and Creditors Rights Section), and the American Bankruptcy Institute. He is a fellow of the American College of Bankruptcy and serves on the Board of Visitors for the Indiana University Maurer School of Law.
