What's changing

We will be upgrading our CM/ECF software to the Next Generation (NextGen) in the upcoming months. Benefits to attorneys/limited users will include one single username and password to log in to all NextGen courts (appellate, bankruptcy and district) where they have permission to file, and also to PACER nationwide—a function known as Central Sign-On.

What you need to do now

1. Get your own PACER account.

Each attorney/limited user must have his/her own individual PACER account. Shared PACER accounts will no longer be useable once the court has upgraded. However, firms may set up a PACER Administrative Account to help manage attorney/limited user accounts and have those individual accounts centrally billed for PACER access fees. Upgrade your existing PACER account.

If your PACER account was issued prior to August 11, 2014, you will need to upgrade it. [Find out if your account needs to be upgraded.](#)

2. Make sure you and all other attorneys or limited users know your CM/ECF username and password.

If the login information is stored in the browser, it will be lost and not recoverable once NextGen becomes active. If an attorney/limited user does not know his/her login or password, please use the [password reset feature](#).

What happens next?

You will be notified of the exact date for the implementation of NextGen as soon as it is known.

Immediately before the go-live date, you will be provided with instructions on what you will need to do when logging onto NextGen for the first time.
