INFORMATION ON CASE ASSIGNMENTS TO JUDGE McCORD AND TRANSFER OF JUDGE LORCH'S CASES

Judge Andrea K. McCord took the oath of office Monday, May 20th. (Her formal investiture has not yet been scheduled.) Judge McCord is being assigned to all new filings in Evansville and New Albany.

Judge Lorch has decided to step aside from active case management. His open Indianapolis and Terre Haute Division cases have already been transferred to the Indianapolis Division judges. On or before Memorial Day, Judge Lorch's open Evansville and New Albany Division cases will be transferred to Judge McCord.

Many of Judge Moberly's open New Albany Division cases are being transferred to Judge McCord, on and after May 21st. Judge Graham will be retaining his open New Albany Division cases.

Each case transfer generates a Notice of Electronic Filing in the affected case and changes the initials after the case number on the docket. Please be attentive to the changes impacting your cases, as Clerk staff will – after a brief grace period – begin checking for accurate case captions and request refiling if erroneous.
