RETURN OF FACE COVERINGS REQUIREMENT, RESUMPTION OF IN-PERSON HEARINGS AND OTHER CHANGES

Effective August 3rd, the courthouses in the Southern District of Indiana return to the requirement of wearing facial coverings and of social distancing, regardless of vaccination status. For more details, consult the District Court general order. Each Judge sets the rules for facial coverings during Court proceedings.

The Judges' approaches to Court hearings have also been changing. In general, the Bankruptcy Judges are now scheduling most hearings and trials for their courtrooms, except for matters set on their Chapter 13 omnibus calendars and adversary proceeding pre-trial or other conferences.
