WAIVING THE FEE FOR MOTIONS FOR PROTECTIVE ORDER
PURSUANT TO FED. R. BANKR. P. 9037**

The Judicial Conference is imposing a new fee in bankruptcy cases effective December 1, 2014. A fee of \$25 is to be charged for motions concerning the redaction of personal identifiers. The Court is allowed to waive the fee in appropriate circumstances. This Court, by General Order 14-0006, has decided to waive the fee for any Motion for Protective Order Pursuant to Fed.R.Bankr.P. 9037. This motion is to be used by a party who seeks redaction of personal identifiers in a document filed by a different party. When a party who filed a document containing personal identifiers seeks to replace it, that party should file a Motion to Remove Document Pursuant to Fed.R.Bankr.P. 9037.
